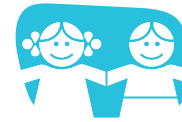


A bold new chapter for kids

Today, Manning Family Children's is a 228-bed, not-for-profit pediatric medical center offering a comprehensive range of services for children from birth to 21 years, with more than 600 pediatric providers and 3,000 employees solely dedicated to the care of kids.

Throughout our history, we have been proud stewards of compassionate care for all children, delivering expert pediatric care right here at home – regardless of a family's ability to pay.

With pediatric academic medical programs with both LSU Health New Orleans and Tulane University School of Medicine, Manning Family Children's is proud to provide the highest level of care for children from across the Gulf South. Just last year, we proudly cared for 585,000 children – the most ever in our history.

In addition to comprehensive services offered at our main campus in New Orleans, Manning Family Children's operates a robust network of more than 30 satellite locations, pediatric affiliations across Louisiana and the Mississippi Gulf Coast, and long-serving community programs designed to meet the health needs of the diverse communities we serve. Outpatient appointments with pediatric specialists are offered on our main campus, and at satellite locations throughout the region, including Metairie, Covington, Hammond, Baton Rouge, Lafayette, Alexandria and Diamondhead, MS.

On healthy days and sick days—and for any health needs in between—the pediatricians at Manning Family Children's are here for families across the Greater New Orleans area. With 17 locations throughout Southeast Louisiana, our pediatricians are dedicated to caring for children from birth through adolescence, serving more than 131,000 children last year.

Nationally leading care for kids

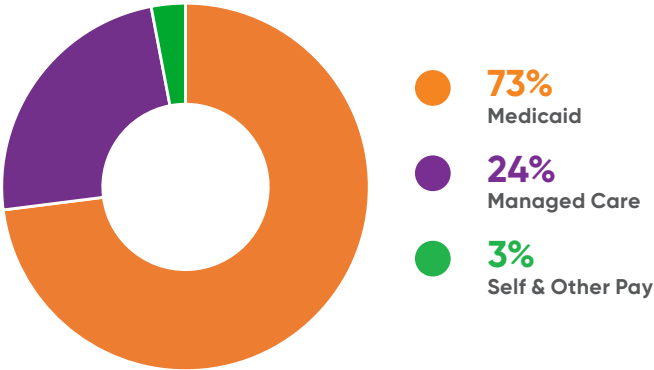

Community support

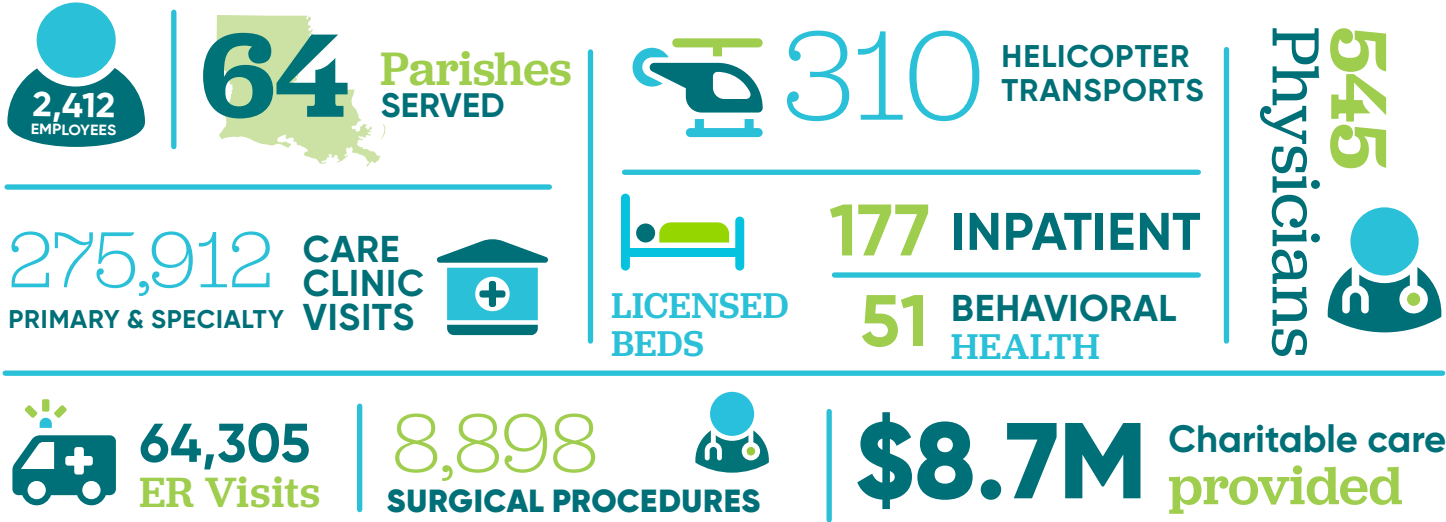
